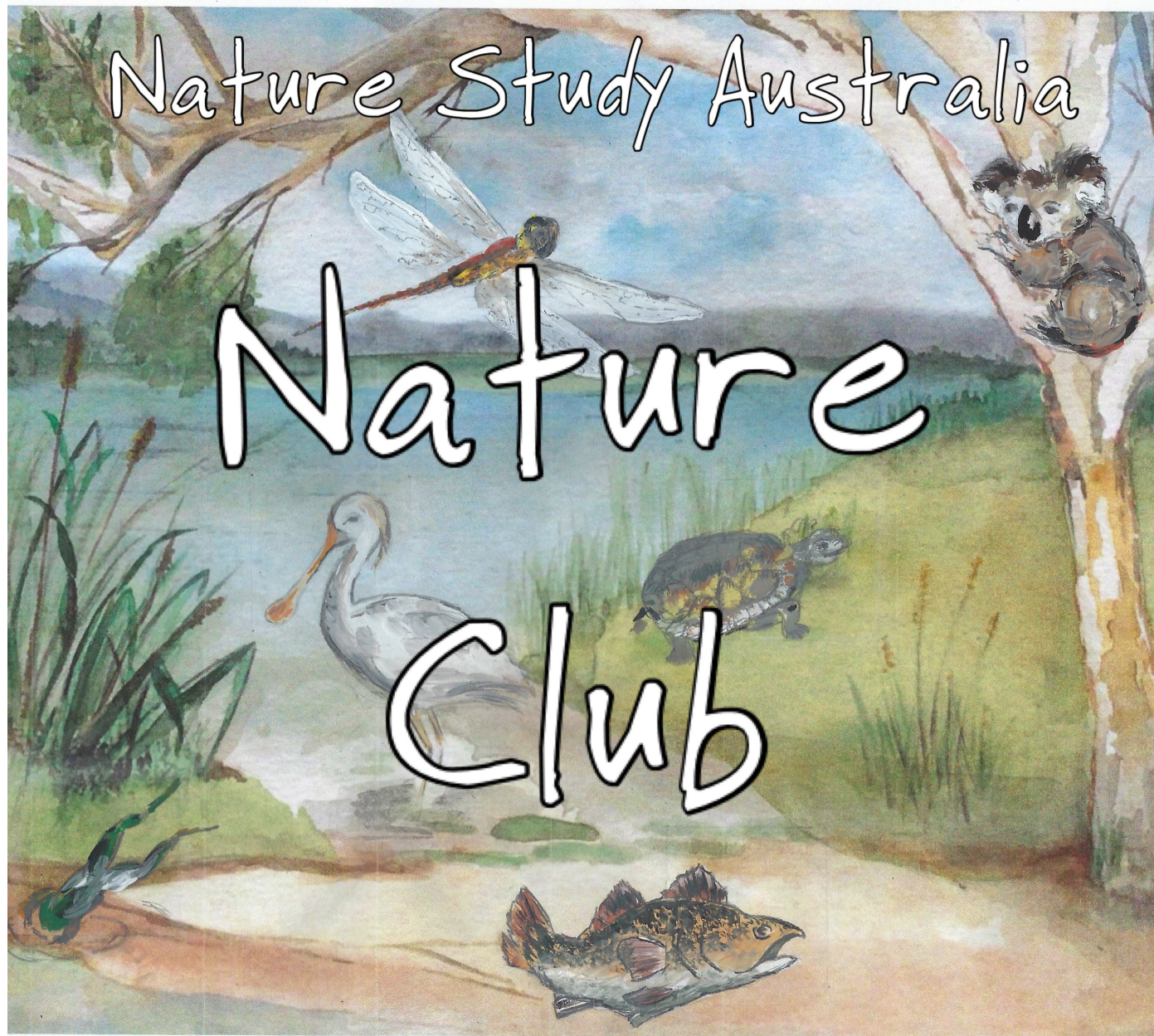
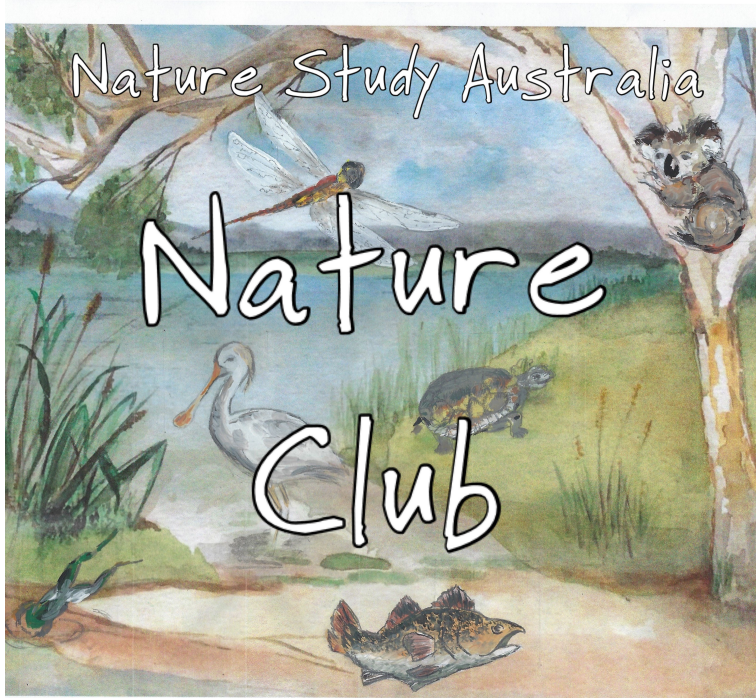

Instructions:

To make the Nature Club badge book:

Print pages 3 and 11 on Cardstock, (this will be the front and back cover). Print pages 4-10 on paper.

Place all pages on top of each other, fit between cover pages, making sure that the back cover is facing out.

Glue or staple the pages together.

Cut the green strip out below. Fold along the center. Glue over the stapled area.

Each of the badges can be found as separate PDF files. At the bottom of the individual badge instructions there are printable badges, you can cut these out and then paste them into your badge book,

OR you can download all the badges as one PDF file and then print on A4 Avery Sticker paper to cut and use as stickers.

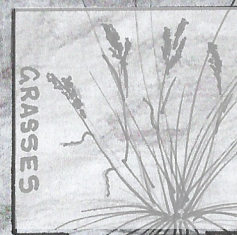

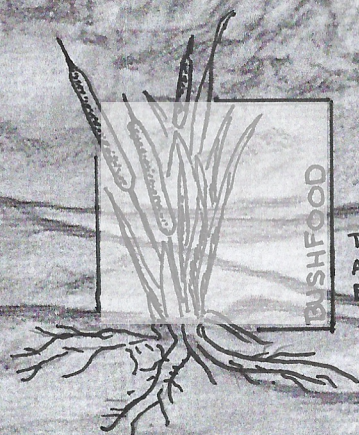
