



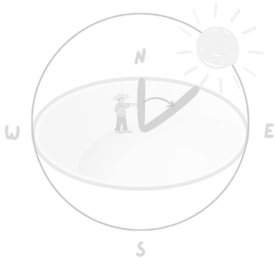
Instructions for the ABC stickers:

The stickers will fit AVERY Labels - code 936074, 99.1mm x 67.7mm Just load the paper into your printer and choose to print only page 2 of this document. You will be able to print 8 stickers per sheet. Each letter will fill the next sticker block so save your sheet for the next letter. Alternatively, you can print on normal paper, cut the sticker out and glue into your math journal.

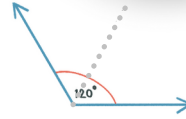
Azimuth



The Azimuth angle is the horizontal angle measured clockwise from North.

Bisect

Like the mid vein of a leaf



To bisect is to divide into two equal parts. The line which divides is called the bisector.

Instructions

To bisect a symmetrical shape, draw a line through the centre so that you have two equal parts.

LET'S LEARN MORE

To Bisect something is to divide it into two equal parts. Collect some leaves. Look at the middle vein, running down the center of the leaf. Carefully tear along the vein. You now have two parts, place them on top of each other to see if they are equal.

It is easy to bisect a shape if it is symmetrical. Why would it be difficult to bisect an asymmetrical shape?
