

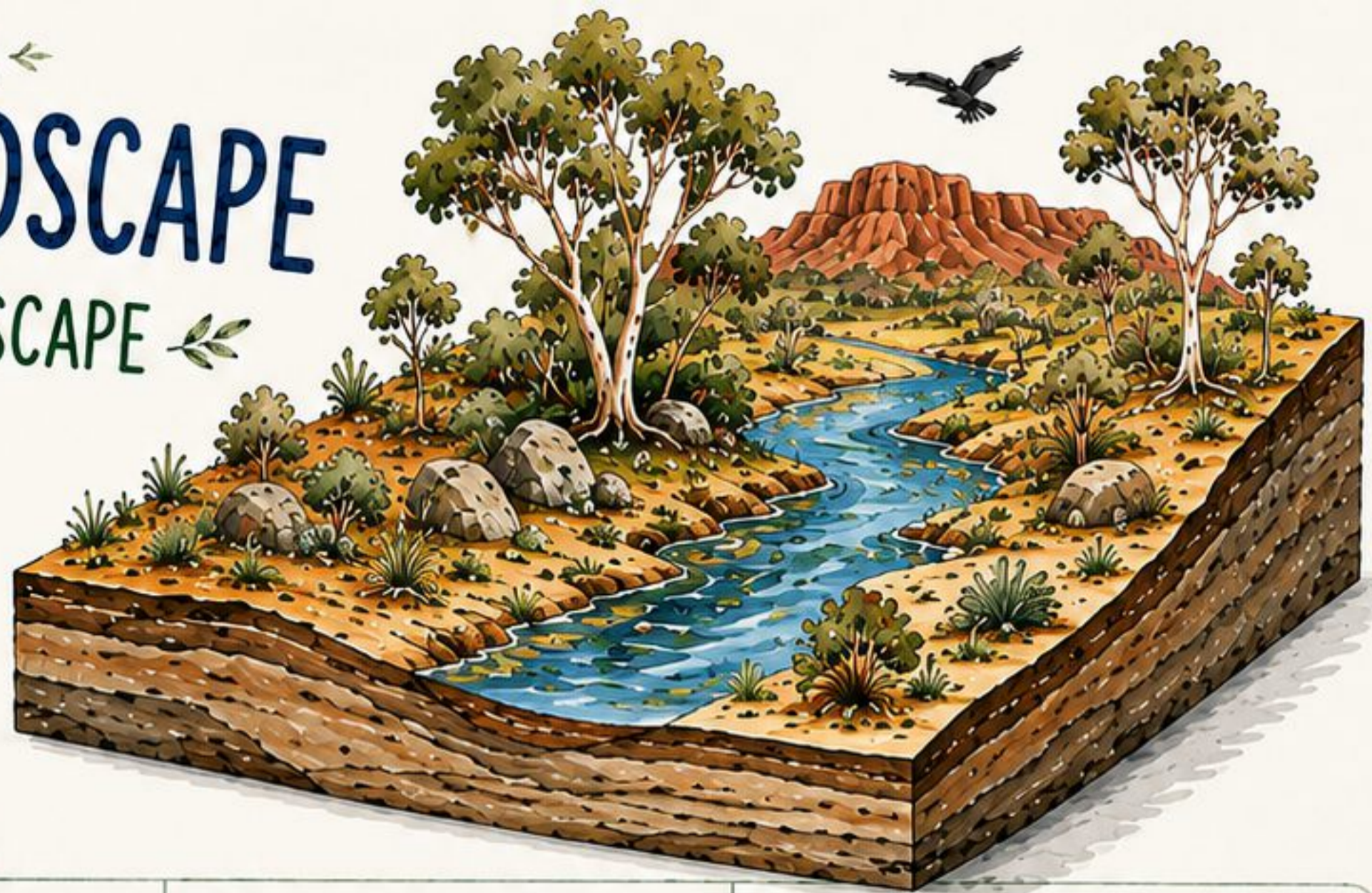

3D BLOCK LANDSCAPE

AUSTRALIAN LANDSCAPE

A 3D block landscape is a mini section of the land, like a slice of Australia you can draw!

Follow the steps to create your own amazing Australian scene.



YOU WILL NEED:

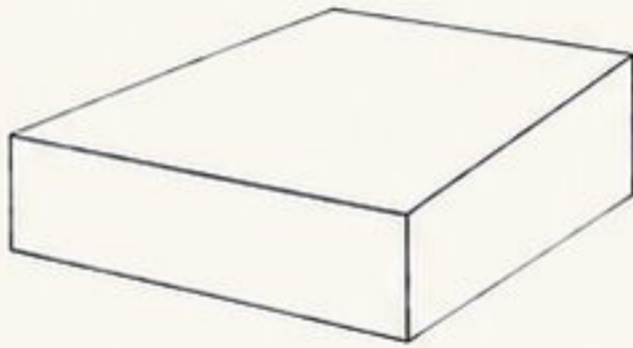
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Coloured pencils
- Fineliner (optional)



STEP-BY-STEP

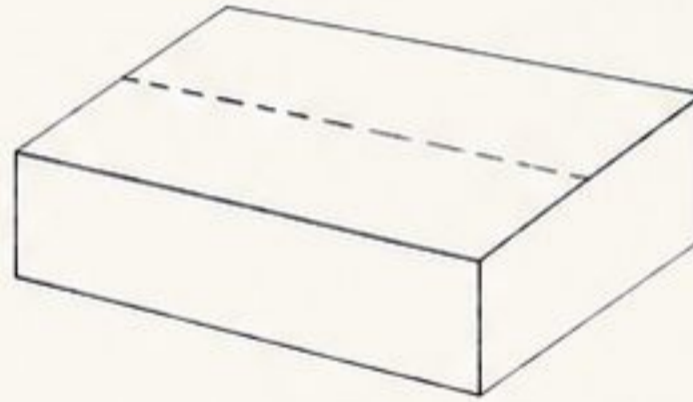
1 DRAW THE BLOCK BASE

Use a ruler to draw a rectangular block in 3D. This will be your base.



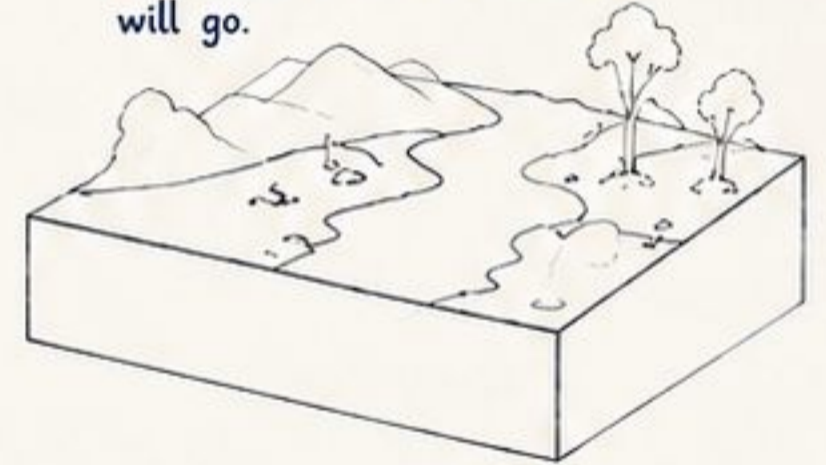
2 ADD THE HORIZON LINE

Draw a light horizon line across the top surface of the block.



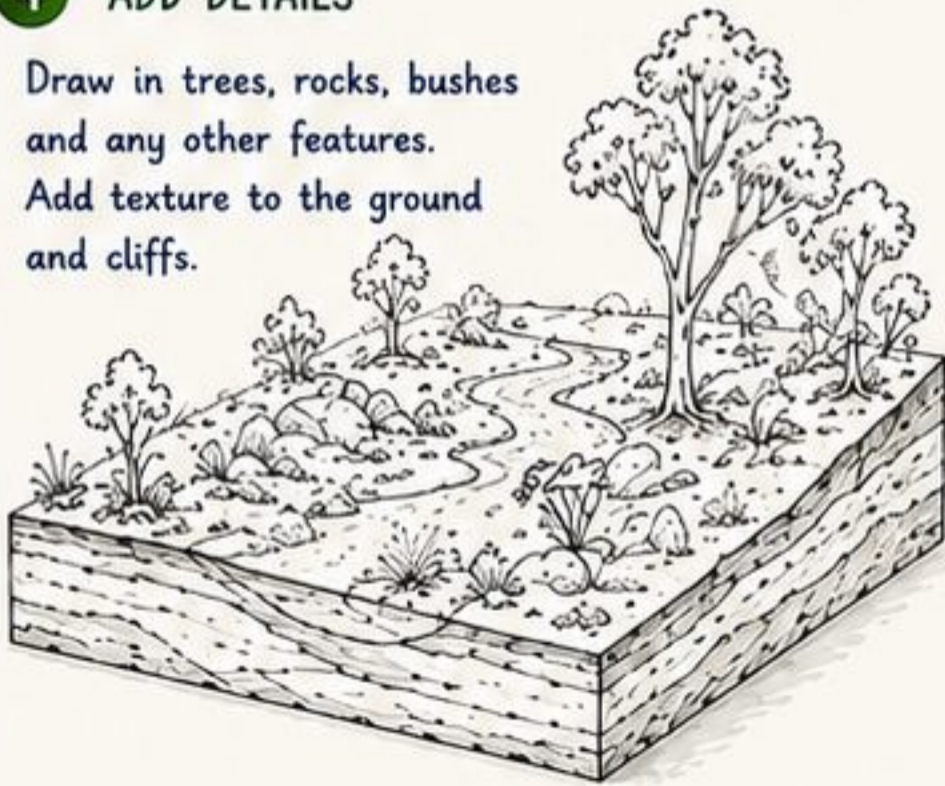
3 SKETCH THE LANDSCAPE OUTLINE

Add the main shapes: hills or mountains, a river or lake, and where trees and rocks will go.



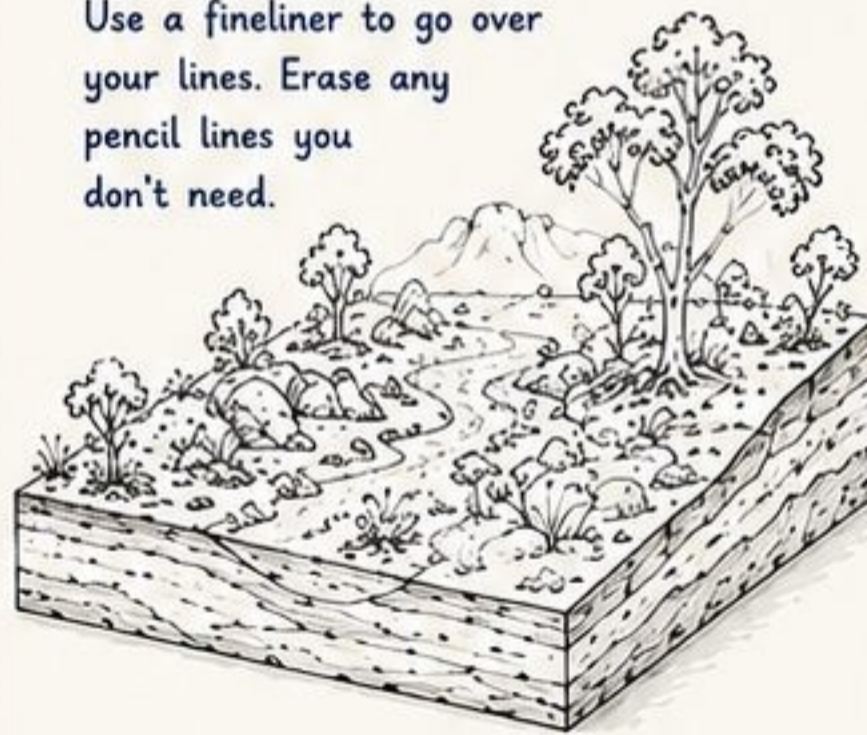
4 ADD DETAILS

Draw in trees, rocks, bushes and any other features. Add texture to the ground and cliffs.



5 INK YOUR DRAWING

Use a fineliner to go over your lines. Erase any pencil lines you don't need.



6 ADD COLOUR

Use coloured pencils to bring your Australian landscape to life! Think about earthy colours, blue skies and native greens.



TIPS

- Light comes from one direction. Shade the sides of the block and objects that face away from the light.
- Look at real photos of Australian landscapes for inspiration.
- Use layers of colour to make your drawing more realistic.
