

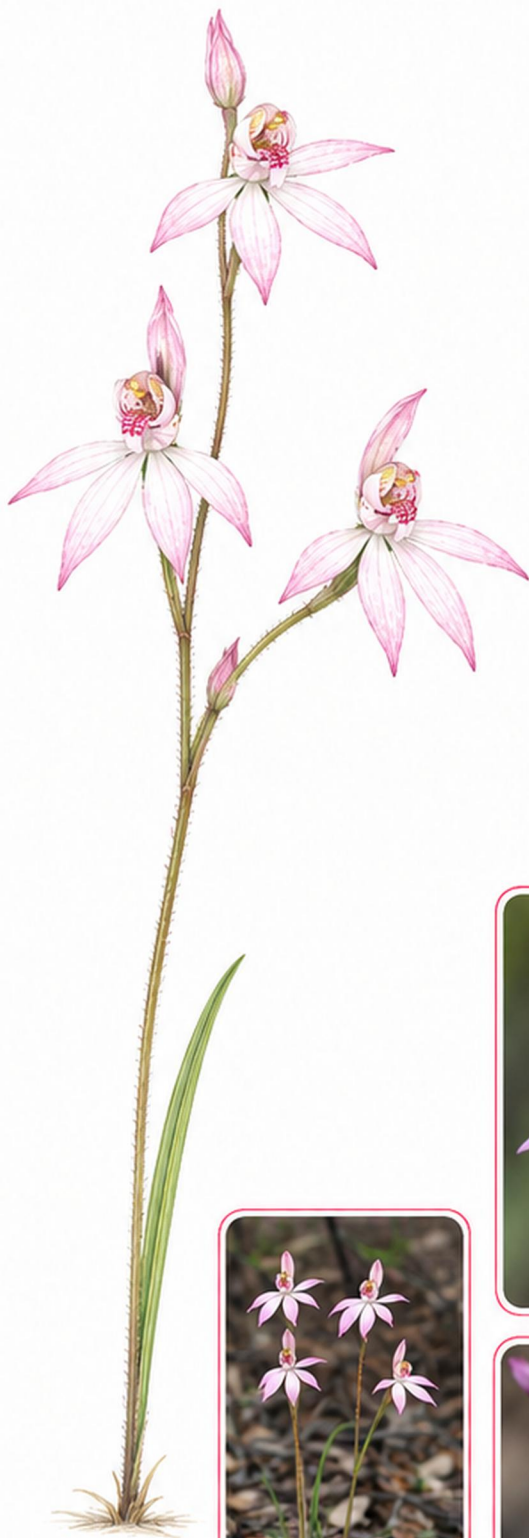
Pink Fingers

Caladenia carnea



Plant Features

- **Height:** Grows up to 24 cm tall.
- **Leaf:** One narrow, linear, sparsely hairy green leaf near the base, up to 15 cm long.
- **Flowers:** 1 to 5 flowers per stem, about 2 to 4 cm wide, ranging from white to deep pink.
- **Labellum:** Three-lobed with transverse red bars and yellow-tipped calli in two rows.



Habitat & Where They Grow

- **Location:** New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, Tasmania and South Australia.
- **Environment:** Coastal heathlands, shrublands, dry sclerophyll forests and grassy woodlands.
- **Ecology:** Relies on underground mycorrhizal soil fungi and generally cannot be successfully transplanted.

- August to December.
